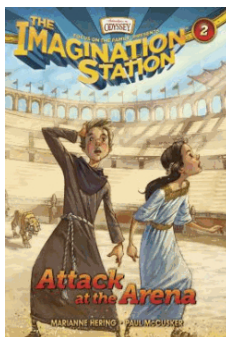


The anxious generation : how the great rewiring of childhood is causing an epidemic of mental illness

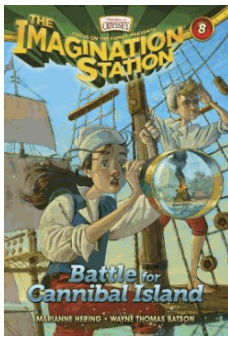


Attack at the arena

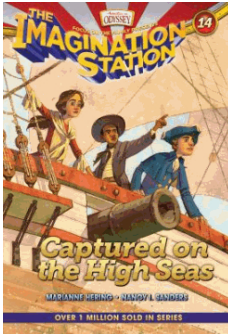

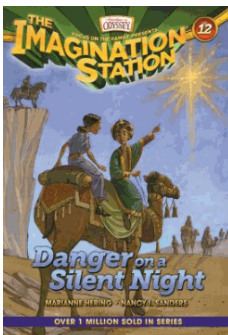

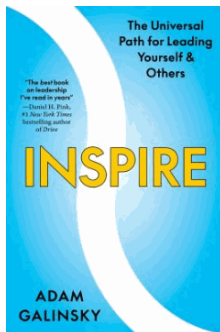

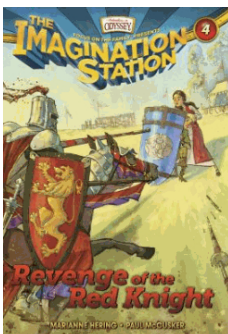

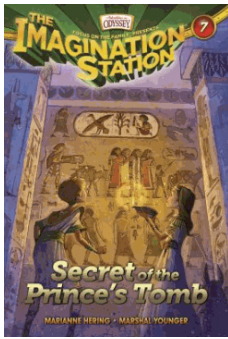

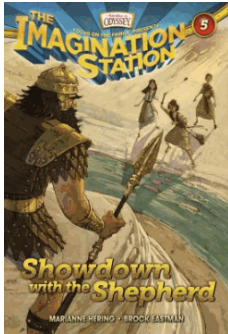

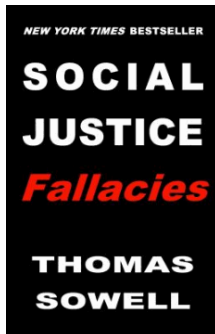

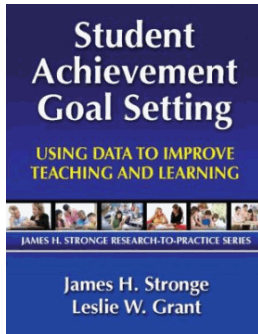

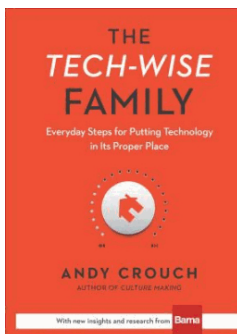

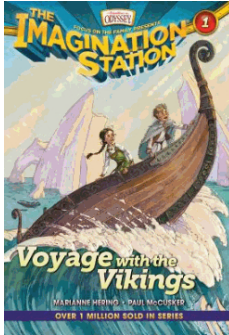


The Overcoat and Selected Stories - Special Edition

One of the most influential short stories ever written, Nikolai Gogol's "The Overcoat" first appeared in 1842 as part of a four-volume publication of its author's Collected Works. The story is considered not only an early masterpiece of Russian Naturalism—a movement that would dominate the country's literature for generations—but a progenitor of the modern short story form itself. "We all came out from under Gogol's 'Overcoat'" is a remark that has been variously attributed to Dostoevsky and Turgenev. That either or both might have said it is an indication of the far-reaching significance of Gogol's work. Gogol's writings have been seen as a bridge between the genres of romanticism and realism in Russian literature.

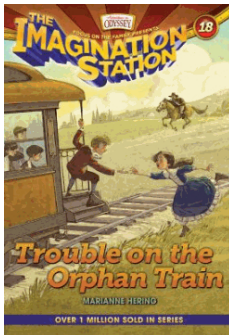

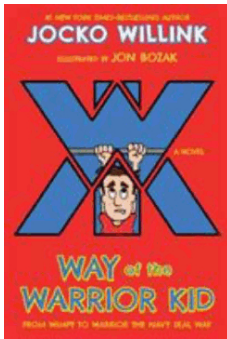
The warden and the Wolf King

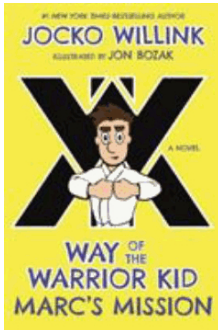

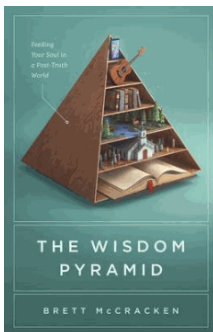
